



Apartment & MTE-MDU Installation

As part of the 1996 Telecom Act, the Federal Communications Commission (FCC) prohibits the restriction on placing antennas in owned or leased areas of multiple tenant environments (MTE's) and/or multiple-dwelling units (MDUs').

Because WorldTV service antennas are smaller than 1 meter in diameter, they can be safely & legally installed in apartment buildings and gated communities facing south with the ability to receive adequate satellite reception.

If your condominium or homeowners' association forbids you to install your receiver package please notify them of Section 1.4000 of the Rules and Regulations of the FCC.
